B&B Distribution's Sisnett Boyce says farewell after 48 years!

SISNETT BOYCE started working within the BHL Group prior to Barbados' independence, and recently he spent his last day in active duty as Customer Service Manager after 48 years.

Reflecting on his life's work at BHL, Mr. Boyce said, "There is nothing as satisfying as knowing that I have been able to solve a customer's problem in a timely manner. I am very pleased with the contribution I have made to the Group and what I have accomplished. My hope is that I have made a positive impact upon the way customers and consumers view our companies and brands."

In 1962, Mr. Boyce began working as an Office Clerk at the Barbados Bottling Company's (BBC) Roebuck Street office. He held that post for 10 years until his promotion to Warehouse Stock Controller in 1972 and in 1981 he assumed duties as Assistant Sales Manager.

Ten years later in 1991, another major development occurred in Mr. Boyce's career, with the purchase of BBC by The BHL Group and the subsequent relocation of the company to Newton. The opening of B&B Distribution Limited followed three years later in 1994. With the establishment of B&B, Mr. Boyce assumed the role of Assistant Sales Manager.

In 1996, Mr. Boyce and a two-member team formed the Customer Service Department with him leading the charge as Customer Service Manager, a post he held until his recent retirement.

Mr. Boyce notes that in retirement he will continue his work with the Lions Club of Barbados South, of which he is past president. He will also make time for playing golf, and most of all enjoy some additional time with his wife, two daughters and granddaughter.
